Seen in Daniel 7 & 10 and Revelation 1

EPHESUS	In his right hand seven stars.		
SMYRNA	The First and the Last, who became dead and lived.		
PERGAMOS	He that has the sharp two-edged sword.		
THYATIRA	His eyes are as a flame of fire, and his feet like fine brass.		
SARDIS	He that has the seven Spirits of God, and the seven stars.		
PHILADELPHIA	The Holy and the True; He that has the key of David.		
LAODICEA	The Amen and true Witness, the Beginning of the creation of God.
